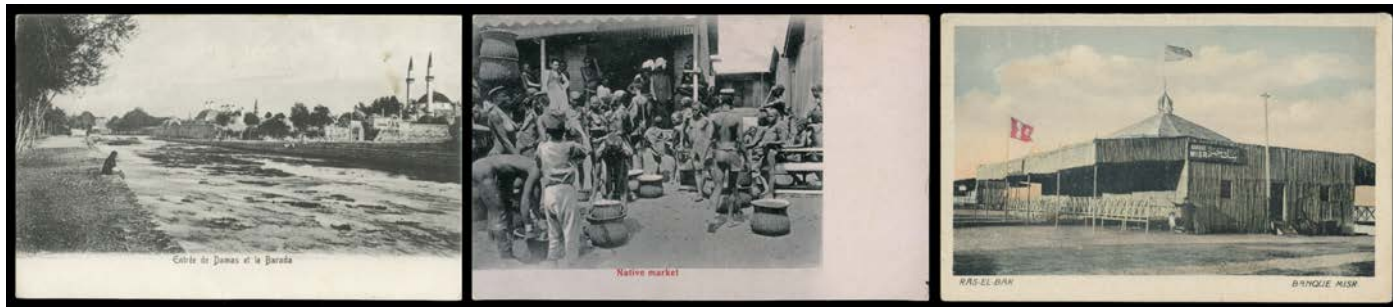

947 C A- - 1903 (May 24) cover with crest of the *2nd Btn Royal Dublin Fusiliers* to Hertfordshire with India QV 1a tied by very fine 'DTHALI' cds, Aden transit b/s of MY26/03 & 'BARNEY/JU6/03' arrival b/s. PO 15.3.1903; closed 14.3.1907. [The troops were sent from Aden to discourage the Turks in Yemen from invading Aden's Western Protectorate. The last troops were withdrawn 30.10.1907. The cover is from the *Commanding Officer, Lt-Col HT Hicks*, to his wife]
