[Tim Rybak's and John McNabb's CTO examples sold at the <i>Prestige</i> auctions of 26.4.2008 and 12.10.2012 for \$2796 & \$3145 respectively] <i>Geoff Kellow</i> stated that three sheets of 36, readily distinguished by placement of the overprints, had been identified. He was able to account for 42 used examples, of which 24 - including this example - are from the First Sheet, on which the second overprint is positioned left and upwards.	2,500
