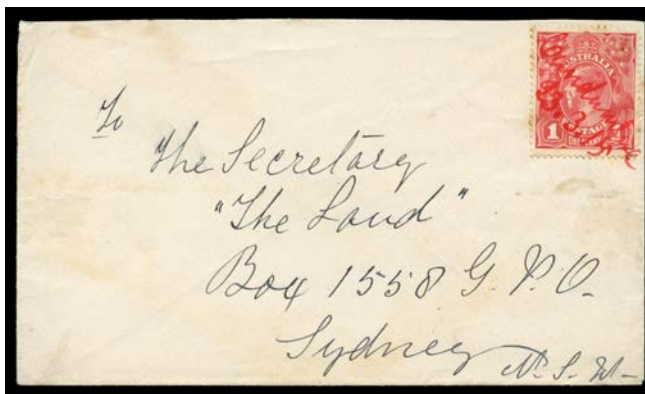

Very scarce group. (7 items)

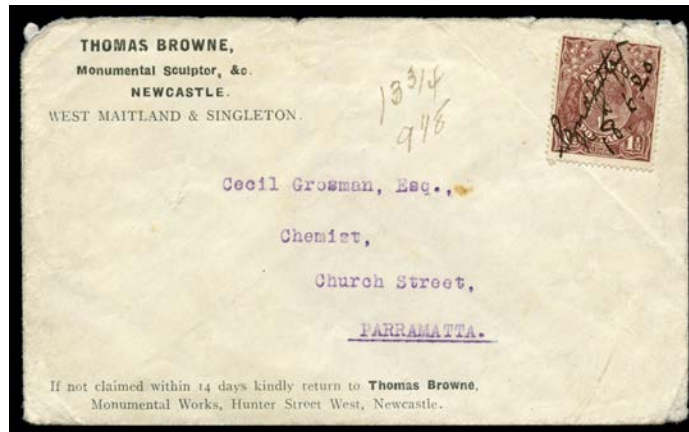

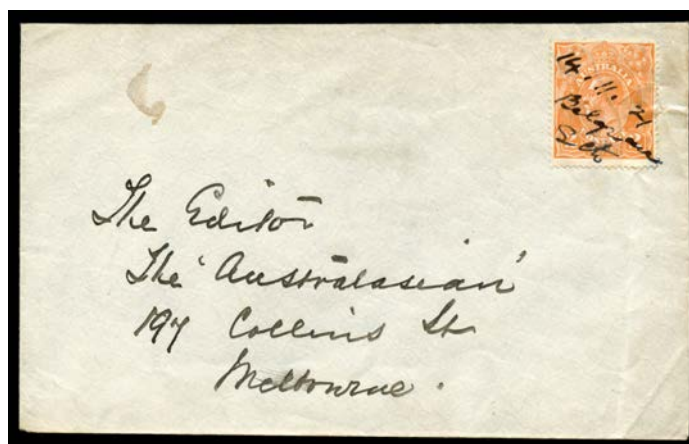

2090 S A A2 **Lake Cooper:** 'LAKE COOPER/5SE16/V[IC]' (**RO period**) largely very fine strike (the 'ER' faint) on KGV 1d red. The later and better of **only two recorded strikes**. RO 21.11.1910; TO 22.1.1920; closed 20.7.1926. [Goulburn Valley; 20km WNW of Rushworth]

2099 D A A1 **Tanybryn (1):** 25½mm 'TANYBRYN/12JE16/VIC' (ERD) very fine strike on KGV 1d red. Rare. **RO only** 16.2.1915; closed 26.11.1920. [Otways: 12km E of Beech Forest]

**Lot 2101**

2101 D A A1- **Tol Tol:** 'TOL TOL/19AU25/VIC.' (ERD) largely very fine b/s. **Only one other example recorded. RO only:** renamed from Banner c.1924; renamed Bannerton 3.1.1926. [14km S of Robinvale]

WESTERN AUSTRALIA - Postmarks**Lot 2157**

2157 D A B1 **Golden Ridge:** 'GOLDEN RIDGE/25AU20/WESTN AUST' with the *Dateline Inverted* (LRD; the only strike recorded in the **RO period**) on KGV 1d red & 1½d brown. Renamed from Waterfall -.6.1911; RO 1.7.1920; PO 1.7.1927; TO 15.11.1930; closed 1.4.1954. [Goldmining, 22km ESE of Kalgoorlie. *PMI* records this second cds in 1914 only, with the dateline inverted. The diameter is given as 28mm. This is an error: it is 26½mm & the arcs are both 2½mm. For the earlier type, the arcs are ½mm]

2160 S A A2- **Lanark:** '[L]ANARK/15AU26/WESTERN AUSTRALIA' largely very fine strike on KGV 1½d red. *Group Settlement* 19. Receiving Office 1/7/1922; PO 1/7/1927; TO 15/7/1929; closed 1/6/1931. [An A2 strike sold for \$310 at the *Prestige* auction of 7.2.2009]
